Nagpur Improvement Trust (NIT) is the planning and development authority for the city of Nagpur. NIT is established under the provisions of Nagpur Improvement Trust Act 1936.

Nagpur Improvement Trust (NIT) has taken up the development of the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Garden at Vaishali Nagar, Binaki, Nagpur on an area of approximately 8.00 acres. The objective is to develop state-of-art garden, based on the theme of various incidents in the life of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar.

The theme of the proposed sculpture and mural work shall be based on:

1. National Integration.
2. Social aspect.
3. Education

Which were integral parts of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's life.

Location: The site of the project is located near 60 feet wide Orange market road, at Vaishali Nagar, Binaki, at the Northern part of Nagpur city. The site is about 2.0 Km from Kamthi Road and is about 1.5 Km from Kamal Chowk on Panchpaoli road. The site is around 15 Km. from Airport and around 5.0 Km from railway station and 6.0 Km from bus station. The site is surrounded by well developed residential locality.

Project History: The existing garden comprises of well developed lush green lawns, peripheral plantations, landscapes, pathways, musical fountain, yoga shed, amphitheater etc. In this garden, various zones are earmarked for the mural and sculpture work. The approximate cost of mural and sculpture work is around Rs. 1.0 crore. Sculptors / Artistes / Architects shall be free to propose their own concept, option and design based on the above theme and shall be responsible for the completion of above work on Turn-Key basis.

NIT proposes to call competitive bids from the competent sculptors / artists / architects having necessary experience, skill and financial capability to take up the sculpture and mural work successfully. The interested Sculptors / Artists / Architects should submit their brief profile of their professional, technical and financial background, list of sculpture and mural works completed with cost and ongoing works in hand. The applicants should submit Photographs / DVD along with the application. The details of the Turn-Key works completed should be submitted in hard as well as soft copies.

The terms and conditions will be elaborated and set forth in the 'Request for Proposal' (RFP) document that would be issued shortly after receipt of the 'Expression of Interest' (EOI). The RFP document would contain the eligibility criteria for participation, the evaluation and selection process would aim to objectively and transparently select a sculptor / artist / architect for the project. The selection process would enable bidders to participate either singly or in consortium to demonstrate the requisite qualification.

Nagpur Improvement Trust invites 'Expression of Interest' (EOI) from the experienced and financially capable and technically sound Sculptors / Artistes / Architects to undertake the project.
